



New Sin Yew is a Malaysian human rights and public interest lawyer. He has more than a decade of experience in the legal profession and focuses on human rights and constitutional law. He routinely represents human rights defenders, civil society, and victims of human rights violation. He has acted in many important human rights cases in recent years including a case to prevent the Government from deporting 1,200 Myanmar nationals to Myanmar during the civil war and the first case on the rights of a child in immigration detention.

Sin Yew has been an elected member of the Bar Council, the governing body of the Malaysian Bar, since 2019. He was the Co-Chairperson of the Bar Council Human Rights Committee, which co-organised the 3rd LAWASIA Human Rights Conference.

Sin Yew is active in civil society organisations and human rights advocacy work. He was previously a steering committee member of BERSIH, the Coalition for Clean and Fair Elections. He is also a sought-after legal commentator on new media, television, and radio.
