Pillkyu Hwang is Executive Director of the Transnational Human Rights Institute at Gonggam Human Rights Law Foundation and a former adjunct professor in charge of the international human rights law clinic at Seoul National University Law School and Ewha Law School.

The main areas of his work include international human rights, migrants and refugees, business and human rights, disaster and human rights, and access to justice in general both in Korea and around the world. He graduated from Seoul National University with an LL.B. and has earned his PhD in public international law at the same university. He was a visiting academic at the Centre on Migration, Policy and Society of Oxford University, and a visiting fellow at the Human Rights Program of Harvard Law School.

He was a member of the Reform Committee within the National Human Rights Commission in 2017 and a President-nominated commissioner of the Special Commission on Social Disasters in Korea from 2018 to 2022. He is the chair of the Committee on International Human Rights of the Korean Bar Association and has served as an advisory board member of the Fortify Rights since 2015 and an editorial team member of the Business and Human Rights Journal since 2019.
