Brian Barbour currently serves as Senior Refugee Protection Advisor at Act for Peace and is an Affiliate of the Andrew & Renata Kaldor Centre for International Refugee Law at the University of New South Wales (UNSW). Brian is currently undertaking a PhD looking at “Building New Asylum Systems from the Ground Up in Asia”. Brian is admitted to the New York Bar as an Attorney and Counselor-at-Law. He was the first Executive Director of a new legal aid organization in Hong Kong from 2008-2011, and the Director of Protection and Assistance at the Japan Association for Refugees from 2011-2017.
