

## The 4<sup>th</sup> LAWASIA Human Rights Conference 2023

### Important Notes

#### 1. Health and Safety Protocols

1.1 In order to prevent the spread of disease (including Covid-19), please check your own temperature on the morning of your attendance.

1.2 If your body temperature exceeds 37.5° C or you are experiencing any symptoms such as coughing, sneezing or a sore throat, please do not come to the conference venue. Please note that in this case, the registration fee will not be refunded.

1.3 We ask you not to attend the conference until you are fully recovered.

1.4 The organisers may ask you to follow certain measures such as wearing masks or sanitizing hands for everyone's protection at the conference and we ask for your understanding in advance.
